Homeschool Hub @ CCE Frequently Asked Questions

Drop Off?

You can drop your child off at CCE you must come inside and sign them in and out.

Can I Stay?

You are welcome to stay at CCE while your child is in class. There is a lounge space available with WiFi.

Can My Child Stay?

If your child is not taking all scheduled classes they are welcome to stay at CCE and work or read quietly in the lounge. We do ask for adult supervision for the younger students if they are not participating in a class.

Can I Sit In a Class?

Parents will be invited into the classes at certain points for end of session presentations. Feel free to ask the class facilitator if you can sit in a class and observe above and beyond this.

How Does Lunch Work?

Participants will be given at lunch break at 11:30. There will be adult supervision during the lunch break and all participants will be asked to help clean up at the end of lunch.

Electrical Devices?

We ask that students do not bring phones, tablets or electronic games to CCE. Situations may come up where a device is needed for a class presentation but we ask that electronic devices be utilized under a facilitator's direction only then packed away.

Sick Policy?

If your child gets sick, it is often most appropriate to keep him/her home. A child who is sick will not be able to perform well and is likely to spread the illness to other children and staff.

Please do not bring your child to CCE if he/she has:

- 1. Fever in the past 24 hours
- 2. Vomiting in the past 24 hours
- 3. Diarrhea in the past 24 hours
- 4. Chills
- 5. Sore throat
- 6. Strep Throat (must have been taking an antibiotic for at least 24 hours before returning to school).
- 7. Bad cold, with a very runny nose or <u>bad cough</u>, especially if it has kept the child awake at night.
- 8. Head lice unless they have been treated according to the nurse or doctor's instructions.

If your child becomes ill at CCE and is too sick to benefit from classes or is contagious to other children, you will be called to come and take him/her home from school.

After-care?

CCE will be running an aftercare program. Homeschool Hub students are welcome to participate for an extra fee. CCE also has regularly scheduled afternoon classes that Homeschool Hub participants are welcome to register for.

Community Service?

Community service is a large part of the mission of CCE and there will be numerous community service opportunities offered to Homeschool Hub participants and their families. A log of community service hours will be kept and we will have an end of year acknowledgement.

Scholarships/ Sibling Discounts/ Work-Study?

Because this is a new program we do not have scholarships available at this time. We do offer a 10% sibling discount. We do have a few work-study positions available (lunch monitor, end of day clean up, admin assistant) in exchange for discounted tuition. Can My Child Drop in on a Class?

We are not offering drop in classes, only six-week sessions. We understand homeschool families desire flexibility and we can offer assistance if your child needs to miss a class but we are really looking for participants for the full week sessions (or hopefully many sessions back to back). Future plans include remote learning as an opportunity.
